



Technology & Digital Learning Centre



Staff Cadets

Senior Cadets aged 16+, PO2/Sgt+, completed at least Year 3 by the end of the 25/26 TY, with a SIN and personal bank account number in their name can be employed to support the delivery of summer training opportunities

Cost

There is no cost for summer training, regardless of course length.



Time Off Requests

May be authorized for parent/guardian to escort the Cadet away from the CTC for a brief period (generally not overnight), subject to course requirements. Sundays offer best opportunity. Completed authorization form and valid ID required.



Training Allowance

All Course Cadets at CTC receive a training allowance in the amount of \$10/day to a max of \$60/week via direct deposit. Cadets must have a bank account in their own name and submit Direct Deposit form upon arrival

Selection for summer training courses is competitive, as spaces are limited.
